The California Association of African-American Superintendents and Administrators (CAAASA) will host a Youth Leadership Summit on Tuesday, March 10, 2020, 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Sacramento Sheraton Grand Hotel, Sacramento, California.

The Youth Leadership Summit is part of our Annual Statewide Professional Development Summit. This year's theme is: Agenda 2020: Strengthening an Equity Coalition for African American and Other students of Color. A Professional Development Summit Addressing the Needs of African American, Latino and Other Underserved Students. The Youth Leadership Summit will provide your students an opportunity to dialogue with educators and leaders throughout the state to understand how to become advocates and work together to impact public policy to ensure that all youth are given equitable treatment in school and the legal system.
